

Remote Lesson Design

CTE Teachers will be working with students Monday-Friday and it is our expectation that **students participate in remote learning experiences daily just as they are expected to attend their program during a period of non-closure**. The following are procedures and practices all teachers will follow:

- Assignments will be posted on Google Classroom, daily, by 9:00 a.m. This will help students maintain a regular schedule.
- Deadlines may be established for assignments. However, teachers will implement flexible deadlines to accommodate the individual needs of students and families.
- Assignments may receive a numerical grade or be marked "complete" or "incomplete." Teachers will provide feedback where appropriate for assignments.
- Google Meet will be used for instructors and students to have an opportunity to ask/answer questions, clarify assignments, and allow for the class to connect.
- Teachers will be available daily 8:00-3:00 (Monday-Friday) within the school day to communicate and assist students and families. Teachers will communicate the hours they are available to conduct teacher, student, family collaboration hours.

Academic Teachers

CTE Academic teachers work closely and collaboratively with technical teachers in providing academic integration. CTE Technical teachers develop and plan content delivery, and the Academic teachers integrate Next Generation English Language Arts, Mathematics, and Science into the lessons. The collaboration between technical and academic teachers include the co-planning, co-teaching, and co-assessing model for integrating academics in a remote learning environment.

Academic teachers assist the CTE technical teachers by posting weekly assignments for each program and academy. These Academic Assignments are posted on the Week at a Glance document for each program at the beginning of each week. Students have direct access to assignments, documents, and/or videos presented by Academic teachers each week.

Student Support Services

To support our students during this period of remote learning, we have developed a comprehensive support system that involves School Counselors, our School Social Worker, Instructional Support Services (ISS), and Technical Teachers.

The CTE School Counselors assist instructional staff with communication by reaching out to families and districts on an ongoing basis to maintain student participation and concerns. School Counselors will continue to be a resource for providing direct and indirect services to students and their families during the closure.

Our School Social Worker maintains communications with students who require sensitive interventions and emotional support during this crisis. We value the wellbeing of students while they are at home in a remote learning environment. School Counselors and the School Social Worker are available Monday thru Friday to assist instructional staff, students, and families.

Special Education Teachers work daily with Technical Teachers to develop instruction that meets the needs of all our CTE students in a remote learning setting. Participation of the Special Education Teacher in a remote learning setting is done collaboratively with the Technical Teacher. Technical teachers work closely with the Special Education Teachers for providing program modifications. Special Education Teachers also work in consultation with School Counselors and School Social Worker for providing assistance and support with student needs.

For our ENL students who do not have command of the English language, Technical Teachers have access to translation services provided by Orange-Ulster BOCES Instructional Support Division. As necessary, phone calls are made to parents by a BOCES staff who is bilingual.

Work-based Learning

Providing CTE students with hands-on experience is a cornerstone of all our programs. While taking their CTE program students receive hands-on experience in one or a combination of experiences on or off campus. Teachers have been working with our Work-based Learning Coordinators to develop hands-on activities that meet state guidelines for approval and can be counted towards the 54 hours students need as part of their CTE program. By default, CTE students earn all or most of the required 54 hours during the first year of their program.

Grading Policy

Fourth quarter assignments will be marked by CTE teachers according to the grading scale listed below throughout the quarter.

Our grading for the fourth quarter is as follows:

- Meets all aspects of the assignment = 100
- Meets most aspects of the assignment = 90
- Meets some aspects of the assignment = 80
- Meets minimal aspects of the assignment = 70
- Work not completed = 60

Students who do not participate during the fourth quarter will receive a minimum grade of 60.

The computation of the final course grade will be determined as follows:

Year 1 Student	Average of Quarter 1, 2, 3, & 4
Year 2 Student	Average of Year 1 GPA, Year 2 GPA (Q1, Q2, Q3, Q4)

For students with extenuating circumstances or who are currently passing classes, we will use grades through the third marking period to calculate the final class average. The extent to which circumstances, which are beyond the student's control, have impacted the students ability to participate fully in fourth quarter instruction will be documented and the final class average calculation (based on third or fourth quarter) will be decided upon by the student's Technical Teacher, School Counselor, and administrator. Any student with a final average of 60-64 will have their average bumped to a 65.

Technical Endorsement and Technical Assessment

On April 7, 2020, the New York State Education Department (NYSED) released guidance pertaining to Technical Assessments, also known as Industry Standard Technical Assessments, with some exemptions, will not be given this year in order for students to earn a Technical Endorsement. Instead, CTE will develop criteria for awarding Technical Endorsements. Technical Assessments are used to award Technical Endorsements as well as provide entry-level job certification for CTE students.

Academies such as our Health Careers Academy must take state mandated exams to become certified in order to work in the health field. Administration of these exams is dependent on state guidelines and reopening of testing facilities. If available, some Technical Assessments for other academies may be offered online, but will not be used to award the Technical Endorsement. We will provide students with information as it becomes available.

Remote Instruction - Expectations for Students

The Orange-Ulster BOCES Code of Conduct will apply to the virtual classroom as it does in the traditional classroom.

Students who participate in a live video/audio conference offered by their teachers must know the expectations regarding their behavior and participation during this discourse. Below is an "Etiquette Guide" that can help with this effort. Please note that the recording, modification, or distribution of video and still images of teachers or students is not permitted by students. The administration will enforce the Code of Conduct if a student violates the above expectations. If an invited or uninvited guest exhibits disruptive behavior during a live session, the teacher will disconnect that student and report the incident to the program principal.

Remote Instruction - Student Etiquette Guide

Muting: When you enter the Google Meet/Hangout, be sure to mute yourself. When not speaking, make sure to mute yourself. This will prevent inadvertent noises.

Questions: When you have a question, type in the textbox and wait for the teacher to call on you. When you ask a question or request information, direct it to a specific individual, and allow time for slightly delayed responses because the system may experience slight delays.

Contributing: When you have something to add to the discussion, but it is not your turn, use the chat feature in the right-hand corner. When possible, avoid interrupting others when they are speaking. Google Meet has a voice-activated switching feature to move the camera to the active speaker automatically. Interrupting another speaker may confuse the voice activation. It is better if you have the Grid View on when you have many students in a Google Meet. <u>Directions to Grid View</u>

Where to Look: Look into the camera when you are talking.

Stay Attentive: Pay attention to your teacher or other students who are speaking.
