| Chester UFSD | Pick up of meals will be from 12:30-1:00 p.m. on Mondays (Tuesday if Monday is a holiday) at Chester Academy, 64 Hambletonian Ave at the top parking lot by the cafeteria entrance. Students who are remote 5 days can pick up a package of meals that are frozen ready to heat, for the 5 day period. Academy students who attend school two days a week and still want meals will receive a package of 3 meals for the days students are learning remotely. Meals will include a cold breakfast, and reheatable lunch for each day. Fresh fruit and fresh vegetables will be included. Remote meals will be free or paid, the same as in-person meals, using your My School Bucks account. |
| Cornwall CSD | Pursuant to federal action on October 9, 2020, effective immediately the district is able to temporarily provide school meals FREE OF CHARGE to ALL Cornwall students, regardless of eligibility or income, through June 30, 2021. Free Remote Day Meal Pick Up: Families are invited to pick up Breakfast and Lunch meals at the Cornwall Middle School on Mondays from 11:30 a.m. –1 p.m. at the rear of the building, for the days your children are learning remotely. We ask that you contact the Food Service Director at abishopp@cornwallschools.com or 845-534-8009 x7704 prior to pick up. Please note that families previously approved for free and reduced meals still need to complete a new annual Free/Reduced application if they have not yet done so. Once this temporary program ends, students will default back to their previous pricing category. |
| Florida UFSD | School Food Services will continue to provide school breakfast and/or lunch to ALL students, both in-school and remote learners. Meals will be modified to ensure student and staff safety. The district will serve all a unitized, bagged meal, which will contain all foods planned for the menu. In-school lunches as well as lunches that are being picked up at S.S. Seward must be pre-ordered via the online Florida UFSD Daily Lunch Form by midnight the day before. Starting 9/14/20, pick-up will be on a Monday, Wednesday, Friday schedule. If there is no school on a Monday, the pick-up will be on Tuesday of that week. |
| Goshen CSD | Meal pickup will be held from 11:00 a.m1:00 p.m. each Wednesday (due to school closure on Wednesday, November 25, pick will be Tuesday, November 24) behind the C. J. Hooker Middle School in the back parking lot. Be cautious and careful driving behind the building. Students who are fully remote (no in-person classes) can pick up a package of meals consisting of 5 breakfasts and lunches for the 5 day period. Students who are hybrid (in-person classes two days per week) can pick up package of 3 breakfasts and lunches for the days they are learning remotely. Meal distribution will continue during the two-week period from November 30 through December 11 while all students transition to a fully remote model of instruction. It will be held from 10:00 a.m1:00 p.m. Wednesdays in the C. J. Hooker Middle School back parking lot. All meals are free. In an effort to best accommodate our families, please email roderick.isaac@gcsny.org to let him know that you will be picking up meals, or if you are in need of special accommodations, such as an alternate pickup day. Meals will include a cold breakfast and a reheatable lunch for each day. Cooking instructions will be included. Fresh or frozen fruit and vegetables will be a part of every meal. If a snow day should occur on a Wednesday (the day of food distribution) then meals will be distributed the following day, on Thursdays, from 2:40-4:30 p.m. |
| Greenwood Lake UFSD | The Remote Food Service Program is available for all K-12 remote student learners. Meals are distributed weekly on Tuesday morning between 10:30AM-12:30PM. To sign up for the Remote Food Service Program, please contact alierow@gwlufsd.org. |
| Highland Falls CSD | Free breakfast and lunch for all students will be available until June. 30, 2021. For those who are working remotely, whether full-time or hybrid, meals can be picked up at Highland Falls-Fort Montgomery Intermediate School on Monday, Wednesday and Friday between 10:30 a.m. and 1 p.m. Breakfasts and Lunches for holidays can be collected during pick-up on the distribution day before the holiday. | Kiryas Joel UFSD | Non-public school sites in the community will continue to distribute meals to all public school students. |
| Marlboro CSD | All school district students are eligible to receive free breakfast and lunch at the Marlboro High School Snack Shack pick-up window on Mondays from 8:00am-1:00pm. Please bring reusable bags and be prepared to provide student name/s and ID number/s. Delivery of meals also occurs on Mondays for those who cannot pick-up. If you have any questions, please contact Food Services Director Fred Callo at 236-5815. |
| Middletown ECSD | Beginning Friday, November 20 we will be distributing TUESDAY and FRIDAY for all children, 18-and-under. Each child will receive Breakfast, Lunch and Snack. Tuesday, will be for 3 days, Friday will be for 4 days. Any child, 18-and-under can go to any of the locations outlined below to receive meals. Please be prepared to carry 4 days of meals- bring something with wheels- strollers, shopping cart, backpacks with wheels, wagon, even a wheelbarrow. Child does not need to be present. 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| Minisink Valley CSD | Starting Monday, Sept. 21, K-5 students will have the opportunity to take home food for the entire week from school. Grades 6-12 students can access "Grab 'N Go" meals at Otisville or the middle school from 8 to 10:30 a.m. daily. Up to three days worth of meals can be picked up at one time, if needed. Sept. 21 update: Please note K-5 families who selected the full remote instructional option for their children will need to pickup meals at our "Grab 'N Go" locations at the times listed above. Important update: Starting Monday, Sept. 21, all breakfasts and lunches will be offered free-of-charge to all children up to 18 years of age. This is scheduled to remain this way through the 2020-21 school year. |
| Monroe-Woodbury CSD | Free school meals are available for pickup daily, Tuesday through Friday from 11 a.m. to 1 p.m. at M-W High School, M-W Middle School, Pine Tree Elementary, North Main Elementary, Central Valley School, Smith Clove Elementary. (Fridays distributions include Monday's meals). Families may pick up meals at the school most convenient to them or if unable to access these sites during the day, they may pick up meals on Tuesday and Thursday afternoons from 4:30 p.m. to 6:30 p.m. at Central Valley Elementary. Please reserve your meals by contacting foodforthought@mw.k12.ny.us. Individuals are reminded to wear a face covering and bring their own bag(s). | Newburgh CSD | Goldback Meal Kits are available for all remote and hybrid learners and all children age 18 and under (if over 18, proof of NECSD school enrollment will be required) EVERY WEDNESDAY (except November 25) at the following locations and times: Gidney Ave 11:00AM-1:00PM and 3:00-5:00PM, Vails Gate 11:00AM-1:00PM and 3:00-5:00PM, NFA Main 11:00am-1:00pm, South Middle School 11:00AM-1:00PM, HOH 3:00-4:00PM, Meadow Hill 3:00-5:00PM. Students do not have to be present. Pick up at the most convenient site for your family. Meal kits include five breakfast and lunch meals. Sign up is not required for pickups for 8 children or less. Beginning 9/16/20, if you wish to pick up for more than 8 children, we ask that you complete a pre-order form and pick up from NFA Main from 8:00AM-12:00PM. | Pine Bush CSD | The Pine Bush CSD is providing FREE curbside weekly meals for children through age 18 and under, regardless of location or family income. Please reserve your meals at www.familyid.com. Distribution during the weeks of Nov. 30 and Dec. 7, 14 and 21 is at Circleville MS on Tuesday 11:00am-1:00pm & Wednesday 3:30-4:30pm and at Pine Bush HS on Tuesday 11:00am-1:00pm & Thursday 2:30-4:30pm. Please note there will be no food distribution on Nov. 25, Nov. 26 or during the week of winter break from Dec. 24-to Jan. 1. The regular schedule for meal distribution will resume on Jan. 5, 2021. Families can pick for other families and children do not have to be in the car at the time of pick up. Weekly packs contain milk cartons, vegetables, fruits, grains and proteins in fresh, frozen, and ready to eat foods that can help extend your family's food budget. We ask that you reserve your meals so we can be ready for you. Please tell us the children's names when picking up no cost meals and wear a face covering. Meals are not available to the general public at any other times. Meals are not guaranteed if you miss your pick up day. Questions / need assistance? | Port Jervis CSD | Please visit www.pjschools.org and click on the yellow box that says "Food Delivery/Pick Up" to complete the form to receive breakfast and lunch delivery/pick up for children in your household during the 2020-21 school year while we are in a remote/hybrid model. Food will be available for pickup for students that do not require delivery services at the 209 complex, HBE and Middle School on Monday, Wednesday, and Friday from 10:30am - 12:00pm. Each delivery will provide meals for the whole school week. Any child enrolled in the Port Jervis City School District will be eligible for either option. The delivery service is to accommodate students in this time of Remote/Hybrid Learning. Monday delivery includes lunch for Monday and Tuesday and breakfast for Tuesday and Wednesday. Wednesday delivery includes lunch for Wednesday and Thursday and breakfast for Thursday and breakfast for Monday. Please be aware that someone is required to be home at the time of delivery in order to receive the food items. The estimated time of delivery will be between 10:30AM and 12:30PM. |
| Tuxedo UFSD | Meals for the week will be delivered to students' homes on Mondays during hybrid instruction. If the district pivots to remote instruction, students will receive delivery of meals to their homes on Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays. |
| Valley Central SD | All VC children from the age of 2-18 qualify for free breakfast and lunch. Meals for remote/online students must be ordered online, via the form found in the "Links" box on their school's webpage (Berea, EC, MES, WES, VCMS or VCHS) each morning, Monday – Friday, by 9:30am. Curbside pick up will be at the school at which the online order was placed from 11:00am until 12:30pm on the day the online order was placed. No meals will be available on weekends or on scheduled school closings. |
| Warwick CSD | During the holiday pause, families currently participating in the food assistance meal service in the Warwick Valley Central School District will be able to pick up meals for students. Pick up will be at the high school on Tuesdays between the hours of 8 a.m. and noon beginning on Dec. 1, 2020. A sign-up sheet has been created and can be found on the Food Service home page. Parents are asked to sign up each student you are picking up for by Sunday evening. Each student will receive five breakfasts and five lunches. If you have any questions or need additional information, please contact the food service department at (845) 987-3050 x 12890/12895. |
| Washingtonville CSD | Students who are in the Virtual Institute or who are home on Hybrid Remote days, may still order meals for pick up at their school. Families are required to place their order for meals by 11:00 pm on the day prior. (ie Sunday night by 11:00 pm for Monday pick up). Each student needs their own ordering form. PLEASE ONLY ORDER MEALS ONE DAY PRIOR TO PICK UP. Families with students in multiple buildings need to indicate on the form, which building will be their pick up location. Pick up times are between 10:30am and 12:30pm. If you are ordering for children under the age of 18 who do not attend WCSD please enter ID# 7777 when placing your ordering. Starting Tuesday November 17th when you arrive at your building for pick up please text the number below associated with your pick up building. Please text your name and students name you are picking up for. Once we receive your text a member of our food service team will assemble the meal and bring it to the door HS (845) 637-4882, MS (845) 637-4906, RH (845) 637-4453, Taft (845) 637-0381, LB (845) 637-5047. At the present time, student accounts will not be charged. You will be notified in advance if the policy changes. |

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
